IA Testing Next Week for Grades 3-8—Be Prepared

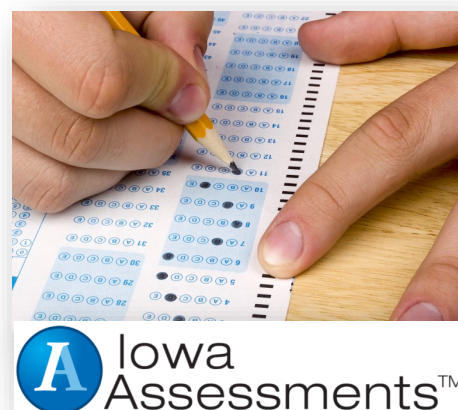
Next week, students in grades 3rd-8th will be participating in the Iowa Assessments (IA), formerly known as the Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS). This is a nationally administered set of exams designed to assess the abilities of students. These tests leverage over 80 years of research and provide our educators a diagnostic look at how their students are progressing in key academic areas. It also offers diagnostic data that can be used to create intervention groups and to drive curricular decisions. The

tests will assess the areas as follows:

- Vocabulary
- Word Analysis
- Listening
- Reading Comprehension
- Language
- Math
- Social Studies
- Science
- Sources of Information

Testing will take place the majority of the week from Monday-Thursday in the morning. Please be sure your child gets plenty of sleep

each night, eats a proper breakfast, and comes prepared to do their best!

- On September 18, the first edition on the New York Daily Times (now The New York Times) was published in 1851.

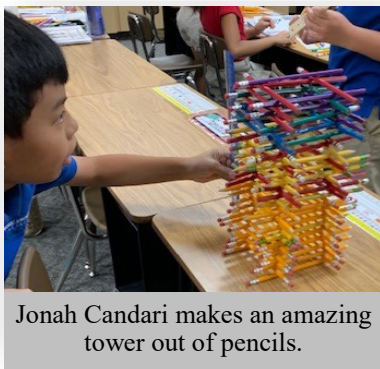
Volleyball Coach Needed
